GS8- Circular Economy Policies and Funding Navigator



Course objectives: This training aims to equip learners with the knowledge and tools to navigate the EU circular economy regulatory framework, identify relevant EU, national and regional funding instruments, and develop strategies linking policy requirements with circular economy projects.

Target group: SME advisors, business support organizations, regional development agencies, VET professionals, and local or regional public authority staff involved in circular economy strategy, environmental compliance, or economic development.

Format and Duration: 8 hours online + 16 hours onsite

Why this course? Participants will learn how to understand the evolving EU circular economy legislation, connect policy frameworks with practical opportunities for SMEs and regional initiatives, and identify the most suitable funding instruments to support circular economy projects.
