GS9- Educate on environmental sustainability concepts



Course objectives: This training aims to provide learners with foundational knowledge of sustainable development, the green transition, and key global sustainability policies, while developing systemic thinking skills to understand the relationships between environmental, social, and economic systems.

Target group: Upper secondary vocational degree students and the professionals in the working life.

Format and Duration: 8 hours online + 19 hours onsite

Why this course? Participants will learn the fundamentals of sustainability and green transition policies, develop competencies to analyse planetary systems and interactions between actors and environments, and identify practical opportunities to act for environmental sustainability.
